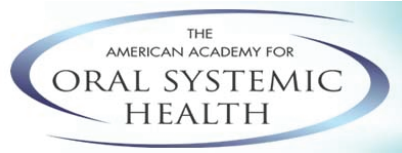

Another 'killer reason' to keep your gums healthy!

New research* suggests that gum disease may actually be more likely to cause a stroke than diabetes, and may be nearly as risky as having high blood pressure.



High blood pressure, also called hypertension, and diabetes are widely recognized as risk factors leading to non-fatal strokes. Evidence of the link between gum disease (periodontitis) and strokes continues to build.
